Please note, these terms and conditions apply to all guests entering the facility for playtime.

- All notices, rules and regulations and wall signs are to be observed and followed.
- An adult of at least 18yrs old must accompany children all times and children must not be left on the premises without adult supervision. Our Staff monitor the equipment and have access to First Aid facilities, but are not responsible for supervising children. Parents/guardians assume full responsibility and liability for children while on premises.
- Outside food and drink is permitted at during playtime. Please ensure all food items are peanut, treenut and nut free. Any food items found to contain nuts/peanuts or treenuts will be removed from the facility immediately.
- Bring socks from home. Socks are required for everyone. Children and adults are required to remove their shoes. No worries! If you forget to bring them we have socks available for sale. Additional charges will apply for purchase of socks.
- Children who are unwell must not use the facilities. Should a child be sick while at Amazing Adventures they will need to leave the premises for risk of infection to other children. No exceptions will be made when children are unwell regardless of medical condition.
- No food, drinks, gum or candy are permitted in the carpeted area, play areas and in the play frame. Food must remain in the general area or the party rooms. No chewing gum is allowed.
- We suggest that you keep all valuables at home. Amazing Adventures Playland is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property brought into or stored on premises. All jewelry and sharp objects must be removed before entering. Pens, buckles, jewelry, watches, money, sharp objects or any objects that may be a hazard must not be taken into the play frame, even in pockets.
- Height and age restrictions are in force in the play frame and inflatables and for the safety of all children Amazing Adventures staff will enforce them.
- Amazing Adventures Playland has worked to design a safe and fun environment for children to play
 but cannot be held responsible for accidents or injuries that may occur as a result of playing on any
 play equipment or for children tripping, falling and bumping into other children or fixed objects.
- Amazing Adventures reserves the right to refuse admission at any time and to ask any person or persons to leave at its sole discretion. Disruptive behavior and bullying will not be tolerated.
